Moses and the Burning Bush ([Exodus 3](#))

Moses saw a strange sight out in the middle of the desert. He saw that there was a bush on fire but it was not burning up. He approached it to find out what this strange sight was all about. As he approached these are the words he heard from God. **"Do not come any closer," God said "Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground (Exodus 3:5)."** This command prevented Moses from rashly approaching God's presence.

The land that was just moments before ordinary and used for ordinary things, became holy ground because the Lord was present. The Lord did not reveal who He was until Moses responded with reverence. After Moses removed his shoes, God had these words to say... **"I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob (Exodus 3:6)."** I believe that God so often wants to reveal Himself to us, but there is something standing in the way. What do Moses' shoes represent in your life? What must you let go of before you can fully enter into the presence of God?
