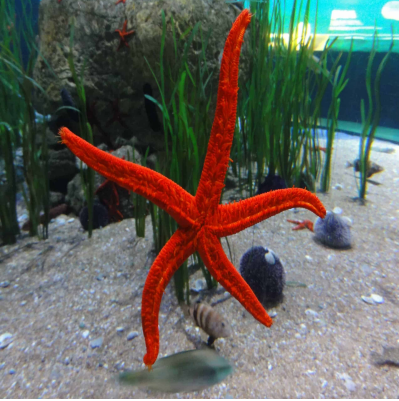




Holy Spirit Duct Tape
