So we unscrewed the cabinet and started again. This time the cabinet landed about 1/16 of an inch from where we wanted it to be. This was okay with my husband, so we left it as it was. Now you might be wondering what kind of lesson I have taken from this... Well, this has made me think about my course with the Lord. I don't want to be even 1/16 of an inch off when it comes to my walk with the Lord. So why was I okay with 1/8 of an inch for the cabinet. Well, the truth is I didn't feel like I would notice the difference.

But I often notice the difference when it comes to my walk with Jesus. I can tell when I've gotten slightly off course. Sure, sometimes it takes me a little longer to realize I'm off course.... But I do eventually come to the realization that I need to get back on course. Are you in perfect alignment with the Lord? I know I'm not! I'm daily realigning myself to God's Word. Daily looking at what needs to change in my life and how I can be more Christ like! I would love to say that I have this down. I'd love to say that I even go through one day feeling in perfect alignment! But it wouldn't be true! I'm a work in progress!
