



Humble Mindset

Description

Let this same attitude *and* purpose *and* [humble] mind be in you which was in Christ Jesus:
[Let Him be your example in humility:]...

Lord, I live to lift up Your name. I live to give You glory! You took my place on the cross, now I pray I can live the rest of my life showing You that I'm so very grateful!

That in (at) the name of Jesus every knee should (must) bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

Lord, please help me to bring this message to all those who have yet to confess Jesus as their Lord. May I take this seriously and may I help others understand their need for a Savior!

And every tongue [frankly and openly] confess *and* acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” ~Philippians 2:5-11 (AMP)
