Description

Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For everything in the world– the cravings of sinful man, the lust of his eyes and the boasting of what he has and does– comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass away, but the man who does the will of God lives forever. (1 John 2:15-17)

My hope is that we can further evaluate where God would like to use us through the different activities we daily participate in.

1. My Bible

Would my Bible be dusty? Would it show any signs of use? More importantly, if someone were to dissect my spiritual heart would they find the Word of God hidden there?

"I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you." ~Psalm 119:105

2. My Email Account

What would my email account say? If someone were to look at the messages I've sent, would they see encouragement towards others? Would they see a heart devoted to God? Would they notice a pattern of optimism or a pattern of criticism?

3. My Library of Books

Would my books show that I desired to get closer to God? Would they show that I hungered for an understanding of God's Word?

4. My Conversations

Would my conversations show someone who was listening? Would they show someone who was available for prayer? Would they reveal a critical spirit? If there was a bug on the wall listening to my every word, would those words be pleasing in God's sight or would I be ashamed of what I've said?

"Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen." (Ephesians 4:29)

Stop and take inventory today. What do these four things say about the way you are living your life? Are you a friend of the world or a friend of God? As for me, I'm still learning in many ways how to be a friend of God! Friday, let's take a look at four more areas in which we can choose to be a friend of God or a friend of the world.
