God will be faithful to us, not because we are deserving on our own merit. He is faithful to us due to His mercy through His Son Jesus Christ. We will never deserve His faithfulness, but we will continue to be recipients of it, as long as we continue to live our lives conforming to His will and not our own. The challenge that Paul gives in Romans 12:2 clearly let's us know where our

conformity needs to be...

"Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will."

Try memorizing this verse in the coming week. It will change the way you think and the way you live. It's a very important verse to live by. Keep it available wherever you are!

GOD IS LIFE

- ~God is a fountain of life! Death came through sin in the Garden of Eden, but life came through Jesus Christ.

- *Death Through Adam, Life Through Christ ~Not only is this so, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.
