Description

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord.
(Isaiah 55:8)

This passage of Scripture tends to make a lot of sense to me. I don't have to dig too deep or look into it too heavily to understand it. I've lived it! I've seen that God's thoughts are much different than my own. His ways are certainly much different than my ways! I'm very grateful for this most days. Yes, I did say most days.
