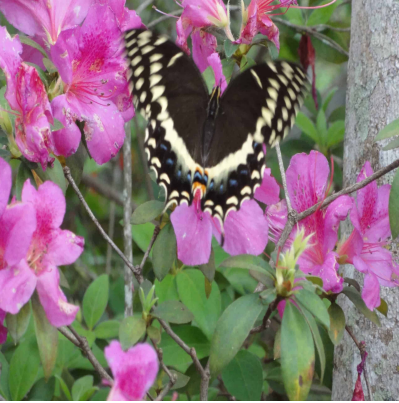




A Forgiving Heart
