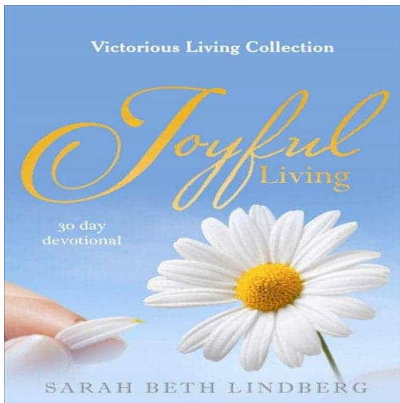




Joyful Living
